1. Foreword

Kick Start to a New Career 2016 - A Youth Career Forum

In the minds of many Chinese parents, the phrase "ideal career" has always been fixated on medicine, law, engineering, or accounting. Although some individuals are strongly compelled to seek success in these fields, others have different visions regarding the definition of an ideal career. Careers do not follow a one-size-fits-all approach. There are a variety of options, both traditional and conventional, which are yet to be explored.

Kick Start to a New Career Seminar is a joint project of the Pui Ching School Alumni Association of Ontario, Vision Youth Leadership Program, and Mr. Godwin Chan, Councillor of Richmond Hill. As many youth are uncertain about their future career choices, we aim to deliver awareness on a selection of non-traditional, yet highly regarded, careers of today. Our goal, by the end of this session, is to have inspired youth to seek a more defined career path for the years to come.

We hope this event will be well received and succeeded by a number of similar forums. Our topics include: Cardiologist, Geriatric Care Professional at the Yee Hong Centre for Geriatric Care, Startup Entrepreneur and Finance Professional, Career Catalyst, Intellectual Property and Business Lawyer, Senior Director of Human Resources, Mechanical Engineer and M.Sc. Systems Engineer/Inventor, Industrial Engineer/Inventor, Corporate Manager at IS Canada, and Licensed Electrician.

In addition, we have invited Dr. Chi-Ming Chow to be our Keynote Speaker this year. Dr. Chi-Ming Chow is an attending staff cardiologist at St. Michael's Hospital and an associate professor in the Department of Medicine at the University of Toronto. He received an undergraduate degree in computer science from Brown University, followed by a Doctor of Medicine and a Masters of Science in Epidemiology from McGill University. At McGill, Dr. Chow completed his training in Family Medicine, Internal Medicine, and Cardiology. He then pursued his clinical and research echocardiography fellowship at the Massachusetts General Hospital at Harvard University before joining the Division of Cardiology at St. Michael's Hospital in 2001.

Mr. Godwin Chan

In the past two decades, Mr. Godwin Chan, a lawyer by profession, has been involved in a wide range of areas. In 1995, he was appointed by the Provincial Government to the Regional Municipality of York Police Services Board. He has also served on the University of Toronto's Academic Board, and the Public Library Boards of Richmond Hill and Vaughan. In his local community, he has served on school councils and volunteered as the Founding Treasurer and Fundraising Chair of the Richmond Hill Road Watch program. When he was elected as a Councillor in 2006, he made history as the first Councillor of Asian heritage in Richmond Hill. In October 2010, he won re-election with over 72% support to serve his second term as Councillor. Godwin has been returned as Councillor with increased support at 73% in October 2014.



In addition to Council duties, Councillor Chan devotes his time to help with worthy causes and serves as Honorary Advisor of a local Lions Club and the Canadian Sinfonietta Chamber Orchestra. In recognition of his contributions as a volunteer, Councillor Chan was bestowed with the honour of Governor-General's Priory Vote of Thanks for his efforts in helping to found the St. John Ambulance's Richmond Hill Youth Cadets in 2013. In 2002, Councillor Chan received the Town's Volunteer Achievement Award.

In June 2013, Councillor Chan was elected by other Mayors and Councillors to the National Board of Directors of the Federation of Canadian Municipalities, and serves on the Standing Committee on Community Safety and Crime Prevention and the Standing Committee on International Relations.

As a father of two, Godwin has a keen interest in supporting youth initiatives and has been involved in planning and organizing the Kick Start to a New Career Seminar with Vision Youth Leadership Program and the Pui Ching School Alumni Association of Ontario since its inception in 2008.

4. Biographies

Keynote Speaker

Professor Chi-Ming Chow

Title: Cardiologist - Director of the Echocardiography Laboratory at St. Michael's Hospital

Dr. Chi-Ming Chow is an attending staff cardiologist at St. Michael's Hospital and an associate professor in the Department of Medicine at the University of Toronto. He received an undergraduate degree in computer science from Brown University, followed by a Doctor of Medicine (1990) and a Masters of Science in Epidemiology (1997) from McGill University. At McGill, Dr. Chow completed his training in Family Medicine, Internal Medicine, and Cardiology. He then pursued his clinical and research echocardiography fellowship at the Massachusetts General Hospital at Harvard University before joining the Division of Cardiology at St. Michael's Hospital in 2001.

Clinically, Dr. Chow specializes in non-invasive cardiac imaging, in particular echocardiography and stress echocardiography. He is the Director of the Echocardiography Laboratory at St. Michael's Hospital and is currently serving as the president of the Canadian Society of Echo (CSE) and the Chinese Canadian Medical Society (CCMS). Dr. Chow speaks Cantonese and Mandarin fluently. He takes care of many GTA Chinese speaking patients in his practice.

Dr. Chow's is highly interested in medical informatics and has authored many popular medical education software programs (e.g. CardioMath, ECG Made Simple, iCCS for the Canadian Cardiovascular Society, iASE Guidelines App for the American Society of Echocardiography, CDA Clinical Practice Guidelines, iSVU Guidelines for the Society for Vascular Ultrasound, and Choosing Wisely Canada). These medical software programs are being used by healthcare professionals and students worldwide. His other current areas of research include ethnic differences in cardiovascular disease, new technologies in non-invasive imaging, and the use of medical informatics to improve patient care.

Dr. Chow had won multiple local and national teaching awards to recognize his teaching and innovation in medical education. Some of his awards include the CCS Distinguished Teacher Award in 2015, the Ruedy Award for Innovation in Medical Education presented by the Association of Faculties of Medicine of Canada and the Dalhousie University Faculty of Medicine, and the 2009 William Goldie Prize for Innovation by the Department of Medicine, University of Toronto.

He has authored multiple peer-reviewed journals and presented in local, national and international scientific meetings.

Dr. Chow is a media spokesperson for the Heart and Stroke Foundation and the Vice-President of the Chinese Canadian Council, Heart and Stroke Foundation of Ontario. He participates actively in health promotion and research among ethnic Chinese. To recognize his service to the Heart and Stroke Foundation of Ontario, he was presented with the Award for Volunteer Excellence in 2007 and the Rick Gallop Award for Pioneering Leadership in 2008.

Title: Geriatric Care Professional, Yee Hong Centre for Geriatric Care

Angela Guo is the Program Coordinator for Assisted Living Services at the Yee Hong Centre for Geriatric Care. She is also a Registered Social Worker in Ontario with a Master's degree in Social Work (Canada) and a Master's degree in Linguistics (China). Prior to joining Yee Hong, Angela has had more than 4 years of direct working experience with newcomers, children, youth, and their parents in supporting their integration into the local school system and community here in Canada.
