1. Foreword

Kick Start to a New Career 2017 – A Youth Career Forum

In the minds of many Chinese parents, the phrase “ideal career” has always been fixated on medicine, law, engineering, or accounting. Although some individuals are strongly compelled to seek success in these fields, others have different visions regarding the definition of an ideal career. Careers do not follow a one-size-fits-all approach. There are a variety of options, both traditional and conventional, which are yet to be explored.

Kick Start to a New Career Seminar is a joint project of the Pui Ching School Alumni Association of Ontario, Vision Youth Leadership Program, and Mr. Godwin Chan, Councillor of Richmond Hill. As many youth are uncertain about their future career choices, we aim to deliver awareness on a selection of non-traditional, yet highly regarded, careers of today. Our goal, by the end of this session, is to have inspired youth to seek a more defined career path for the years to come.

We hope this event will be well received and succeeded by a number of similar forums. Our topics include: Cardiologist, Geriatric Care Professional at the Yee Hong Centre for Geriatric Care, Startup Entrepreneur and Finance Professional, Career Catalyst, Intellectual Property and Business Lawyer, Senior Director of Human Resources, Mechanical Engineer and M.Sc. Systems Engineer/Inventor, Industrial Engineer/Inventor, Corporate Manager at IS Canada, and Licensed Electrician.

In addition, we have invited Dr. Chi-Ming Chow to be our Keynote Speaker this year. Dr. Chi-Ming Chow is an attending staff cardiologist at St. Michael's Hospital and an associate professor in the Department of Medicine at the University of Toronto. He received an undergraduate degree in computer science from Brown University, followed by a Doctor of Medicine and a Masters of Science in Epidemiology from McGill University. At McGill, Dr. Chow completed his training in Family Medicine, Internal Medicine, and Cardiology. He then pursued his clinical and research echocardiography fellowship at the Massachusetts General Hospital at Harvard University before joining the Division of Cardiology at St. Michael's Hospital in 2001.

Mr. Godwin Chan

In the past two decades, Mr. Godwin Chan, a lawyer by profession, has been involved in a wide range of areas. In 1995, he was appointed by the Provincial Government to the Regional Municipality of York Police Services Board. He has also served on the University of Toronto's Academic Board, and the Public Library Boards of Richmond Hill and Vaughan. In his local community, he has served on school councils and volunteered as the Founding Treasurer and Fundraising Chair of the Richmond Hill Road Watch program. When he was elected as a Councillor in 2006, he made history as the first Councillor of Asian heritage in Richmond Hill. In October 2010, he won re-election with over 72% support to serve his second term as Councillor. Godwin has been returned as Councillor with increased support at 73% in October 2014.



In addition to Council duties, Councillor Chan devotes his time to help with worthy causes and serves as Honorary Advisor of a local Lions Club and the Canadian Sinfonietta Chamber Orchestra. In recognition of his contributions as a volunteer, Councillor Chan was bestowed with the honour of Governor-General's Priority Vote of Thanks for his efforts in helping to found the St. John Ambulance's Richmond Hill Youth Cadets in 2013. In 2002, Councillor Chan received the Town's Volunteer Achievement Award.

In June 2013, Councillor Chan was elected by other Mayors and Councillors to the National Board of Directors of the Federation of Canadian Municipalities, and serves on the Standing Committee on Community Safety and Crime Prevention and the Standing Committee on International Relations.

As a father of two, Godwin has a keen interest in supporting youth initiatives and has been involved in planning and organizing the Kick Start to a New Career Seminar with VisionYouth Leadership Program and the Pui Ching School Alumni Association of Ontario since its inception in 2008.

Keynote Speaker

Helen Poon, Ed. D.

Title: Mental Health Specialist 心理健康專家

Recovery Programs Manager at Hong Fook Mental Health Association 康復服務部經理

Helen Poon is the Manager of Recovery Programs at Hong Fook Mental Health Association, overseeing the Self Help Program, Family Initiative, and Psychotherapy program. In her daily work, Helen has strived to promote mental wellness, reduce stigma attached to mental illness, and support programs that facilitate recovery of people with mental illness. Helen received her Doctor of Education degree from Ontario of Studies in Education at University of Toronto in 2004 and had been a teacher educator in Hong Kong for more than 10 years.

Before landing on the current job, Helen had been the Executive Director of Chinese Canadian National Council Toronto Chapter from 2004 to 2005, advocating for the human rights of Chinese Canadians in Toronto. From 2007 to 2011, Helen was the Community Mission Specialist for the Chinese community at the Heart and Stroke Foundation of Canada, working diligently to promote heart health among Chinese Canadians across Ontario. She was also the Founder and Co-chair of the Ontario Chinese Health Coalition, which is a multi-disciplinary collaborative aiming to promote and improve the health of Chinese communities across Ontario by advancing health promotion and advocacy through strategic partnerships, knowledge exchange and collective action.

In 2017, Helen was recognized by the Celebration "15": Voices of Chinese Canadian Women in Ontario as the 15 Community recipients who provided leadership in the arts, civic engagement, culture, education, and community building.

Anna Victoria Wong has over 20 years of experience in the corporate and community sectors, leveraging her public relations and management expertise to educate the public on important social issues. A Certified Health Executive, she is currently the Executive Director of Chinese Family Services of Ontario. Each year, her agency serves close to 5,000 families affected by domestic violence, mental health disorders, adjustment issues, and family crises, to improve the psychosocial well-being of the Chinese community in Ontario. A Doctor of Speech-Language Pathology, Anna also advocated for the population with invisible disabilities, and was the recipient of the 2013 Communicative Access award for championing an education and therapy series for patients suffering from communicative disabilities in the Chinese community. Anna serves patients with her

speech-language pathology expertise outside of work hours, rehabilitating children with speech-language delays, and adults with traumatic brain injury, or speech or swallowing issues from cancer, stroke, or aging.

Carmen Chan MBA, CIM, LLQP

Carmen Chan, MBA, CIM, LLQP, Qualified Accountant, is a retired banking professional who has worked for major banks in Canada and Hong Kong for over 20 years. Carmen was a commentator for financial news in TV & Radio broadcasts. She is also Emcee for various community events. As a loving mother of two sons, she has been actively involved in community services such as being Interpretation team leader and group leader for EQ Parenting Ministry since 2009, Mentoring university students and Boarding Families, and Executive board members of various alumni organizations since 1997.
