The Pui Ching School was founded in Guangzhou, China in 1889. In 1933, the Hong Kong Branch was established. The Pui Ching Alumni Association of Ontario was formed in the 1970s in Toronto. Today there are over 40 alumni associations located in most of the major cities around the world.

The Pui Ching Alumni Association of Ontario consists of more than 1 000 alumni, most of which reside in the GTA. Some of its objectives are as follows:



- a) To promote, support, and protect the common interests of the members of the Association.
- b) To participate in intellectual and cultural activities in the community.
- c) To strengthen and promote fellowship amongst Pui Ching School Alumni across the globe.

Annual functions include the Annual General Meeting (AGM) dinner, a joint schools barbecue, seminars, golf and badminton tournaments, and a Christmas dinner.

Vision Youth Leadership Program

The Vision Youth Leadership Program was founded in 2001 to provide participants with non-academic life skills such as social and environmental awareness, leadership qualities, and outdoor survival skills. Developed by Canada-Hong Kong Link, this multi-faceted youth leadership training program has three levels (Bronze, Silver, Gold), each of which spans a course of six months. Its goal is to aid participants in realizing their full potential and to ultimately thrive as passionate, visionary leaders of the future.

Mr. Godwin Chan

For over two decades, Mr. Godwin Chan, a lawyer by profession, has been involved in a wide range of areas. In 1995, he was appointed by the Provincial Government to the Regional Municipality of York Police Services Board. He has also served on the University of Toronto's Academic Board, and the Public Library Boards of Richmond Hill and Vaughan. In his local community, he has served on school councils and volunteered as the Founding Treasurer and Fundraising Chair of the Richmond Hill Road Watch program. In 2002, Godwin received Richmond Hill's Volunteer Achievement Award.



When he was elected as a Councillor in 2006, he made history as the first Councillor of non-white background in Richmond Hill. In October 2010, he won re-election with over 72% support to serve his second term as Councillor. Godwin has been returned as Councillor with increased support at 73% in October 2014.

Since elected by municipal peers to the Board of Directors of the Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM) in 2013, Godwin Chan has served on FCM Standing Committees on Community Safety and Crime Prevention, International Relations, Municipal Finance and Intergovernmental Arrangements, and Municipal Infrastructure and Transportation. At present, he is serving his 5th term on FCM's national Board, and is continuing to advocate strongly for Federal Government's investment in public infrastructure, housing and innovation that make stronger local communities.

In addition to Council duties, Councillor Chan devotes his time to help with worthy causes and serves as Honorary Advisor of a local Lions Club and the Canadian Sinfonietta Chamber Orchestra. As a volunteer, he helped to found the Youth Cadets of St. John Ambulance in Richmond Hill in 2013 and was awarded the Governor-General's Priority Vote of Thanks. In 2016, he was recognized for making a positive difference in Canada and was chosen as one of the recipients of the RBC Top 25 Canadian Immigrant Awards. In 2017, Canada's 150th anniversary of Confederation, Godwin is honoured to be selected as one of the three Canada 150 Community Leaders in Richmond Hill.

As a father of two, Godwin has a keen interest in supporting youth initiatives and has been involved in planning and organizing the Kick Start to a New Career seminars with VisionYouth Leadership Program and the Pui Ching School Alumni Association of Ontario since its inception in 2008.

4. Biographies

Keynote Speaker

The Honourable Mary Ng

Title: MP, Minister of Small Business and Export Promotion 小企業和出口促進部長



The Honourable Mary Ng was first elected as the Member of Parliament for Markham—Thornhill in April 2017 and was appointed Minister of Small Business and Export Promotion in July 2018.

Throughout her 20 years of public service, Minister Ng has been a passionate community leader and advocate with a proven track record of results in the areas of education, women's leadership, job-creation, and entrepreneurship.

As Member of Parliament for Markham—Thornhill, Minister Ng helped to facilitate the Government's commitment to invest in Canadian ideas and innovators in her riding by advocating for the inclusion of Markham's tech-innovation hub, VentureLabs, in the Southern Ontario Supercluster. The Advanced Manufacturing Supercluster is expected to have a GDP impact of more than \$13.5 billion in the next ten years and create more than 13,500 good, middle class jobs in the region.

As part of her work on the Standing Committee of Industry, Science, and Technology, Minister Ng worked alongside her committee colleagues on intellectual property best practices. This work guided the Government's launch of Canada's first comprehensive intellectual property strategy, providing tools to support the growth of Canadian businesses domestically while ensuring their ideas are protected in the global marketplace.

Prior to serving as a Member of Parliament, Minister Ng worked as Director of Appointments in the Prime Minister's Office. She also served as the Director of Policy in provincial education where she built relationships, negotiated with teachers' unions, and served students while helping to improve Ontario's education system.

Minister Ng also served in the President's Office at Ryerson University, helping to shape new initiatives that connected students and their innovative ideas with businesses, creating quality jobs for young Canadians. She has been a speaker and panelist on topics ranging from business, innovation, women in leadership and Canada-China relations.

Prof. Dr. Wai Lun Alan Fung, M.D., Sc.D

Title: Psychiatrist, Research Professor 精神科醫生/研究教授



Dr. Alan Fung is a physician board-certified in the

specialties/subspecialties of psychiatry, sleep medicine, and behavioral neurology & neuropsychiatry. He is an attending physician and the Medical Director of Research at the North York General Hospital Department of Psychiatry, and he chairs the Research Ethics Board of the Hospital. He is a Research Professor at the Tyndale University College & Seminary, as well as a faculty member at the University of Toronto Faculty of Medicine and Collaborative Program in Neuroscience. His main professional interests include: i) cultural and spiritual dimensions of mental health care; ii) neuropsychiatry and genetics; iii) mental health promotion; iv) interprofessional collaborations and education; v) health professional education. He has served in leadership roles in various organizations at the local, national and international levels. Dr. Fung obtained his Bachelor of Science (BSc), Doctor of Medicine (MD) as well as medical specialist (residency) training in psychiatry from the University of Toronto; a Master's degree from the University of Cambridge, UK; and a Research Doctorate from Harvard University. He is a Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians of Canada (in Psychiatry), as well as of the American Psychiatric Association.

He quickly climbed up the ladder and achieved the rank of Warrant Officer 2nd Class, and has gone through intensive training in aviation. Although in the end he wasn't able to obtain his pilot's license due to extenuating circumstances, he gained valuable experience in familiarization flying, air traffic control, and the space training program. In 2012, Joe graduated from Centennial College and obtained a diploma in Aircraft Technician - Aircraft Maintenance with accreditation from Transport Canada. Spencer Wong is a litigation lawyer at TD Insurance Meloche Monnex


