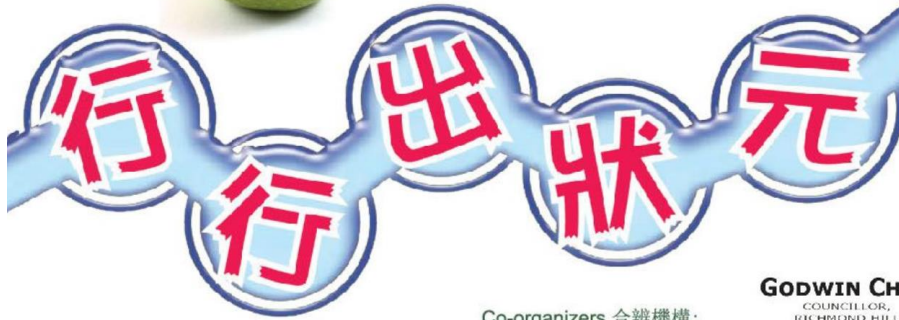

The Pui Ching School was founded in Guangzhou, China in 1889. In 1933, the Hong Kong Branch was established. The Pui Ching Alumni Association of Ontario was formed in the 1970s in Toronto. Today there are over 40 alumni associations located in most of the major cities around the world.



The Pui Ching Alumni Association of Ontario consists of more than 1 000 alumni, most of which reside in the GTA. Some of its objectives are as follows:

- a) To promote, support, and protect the common interests of the members of the Association.
- b) To participate in intellectual and cultural activities in the community.
- c) To strengthen and promote fellowship amongst Pui Ching School Alumni across the globe.

Annual functions include the Annual General Meeting (AGM) dinner, a joint schools barbecue, seminars, golf and badminton tournaments, and a Christmas dinner.

Vision Youth Leadership Program

The Vision Youth Leadership Program was founded in 2001 to provide participants with non-academic life skills such as social and environmental awareness, leadership qualities, and outdoor survival skills. Developed by Canada-Hong Kong Link, this multi-faceted youth leadership training program has three levels (Bronze, Silver, Gold), each of which spans a course of six months. Its goal is to aid participants in realizing their full potential and to ultimately thrive as passionate, visionary leaders of the future.

Mr. Godwin Chan

For over two decades, Mr. Godwin Chan, a lawyer by profession, has been involved in a wide range of areas. In 1995, he was appointed by the Provincial Government to the Regional Municipality of York Police Services Board. He has also served on the University of Toronto's Academic Board, and the Public Library Boards of Richmond Hill and Vaughan. In his local community, he has served on school councils and volunteered as the Founding Treasurer and Fundraising Chair of the Richmond Hill Road Watch program. In 2002, Godwin received Richmond Hill's Volunteer Achievement Award.



When he was elected as a Councillor in 2006, he made history as the first Councillor of non-white background in Richmond Hill. In October 2010, he won re-election with over 72% support to serve his second term as Councillor. Godwin has been returned as Councillor with increased support at 73% in October 2014.

Since elected by municipal peers to the Board of Directors of the Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM) in 2013, Godwin Chan has served on FCM Standing Committees on Community Safety and Crime Prevention, International Relations, Municipal Finance and Intergovernmental Arrangements, and Municipal Infrastructure and Transportation. At present, he is serving his 5th term on FCM's national Board, and is continuing to advocate strongly for Federal Government's investment in public infrastructure, housing and innovation that make stronger local communities.

In addition to Council duties, Councillor Chan devotes his time to help with worthy causes and serves as Honorary Advisor of a local Lions Club and the Canadian Sinfonietta Chamber Orchestra. As a volunteer, he helped to found the Youth Cadets of St. John Ambulance in Richmond Hill in 2013 and was awarded the Governor-General's Priority Vote of Thanks. In 2016, he was recognized for making a positive difference in Canada and was chosen as one of the recipients of the RBC Top 25 Canadian Immigrant Awards. In 2017, Canada's 150th anniversary of Confederation, Godwin is honoured to be selected as one of the three Canada 150 Community Leaders in Richmond Hill.

As a father of two, Godwin has a keen interest in supporting youth initiatives and has been involved in planning and organizing the Kick Start to a New Career seminars with VisionYouth Leadership Program and the Pui Ching School Alumni Association of Ontario since its inception in 2008.

4. Biographies

Keynote Speaker

Prof. Dr. Kenneth Fung MD FRCPC MSc FAPA FCPA

Title: Clinical Director, Asian Initiative in Mental Health. Associate Professor, University of Toronto 亞裔
精神健康臨床實驗主管, 多倫多大學副教授

Dr. Kenneth Fung is a Staff Psychiatrist and Clinical Director of the Asian Initiative in Mental Health Program at the Toronto Western Hospital, University Health Network, and Associate Professor with Equity, Gender, and Populations Division at the Department of Psychiatry, University of Toronto. He completed a two-year fellowship in Cultural Psychiatry at the University of Toronto, and his Master thesis was on alexithymia among Chinese Canadians. His primary research, teaching, and clinical interests include both cultural psychiatry and psychotherapy. He is the Block Co-coordinator of the Cultural Psychiatry Core Seminars for psychiatry residents at the university. He is the seminar co-lead and psychotherapy supervisor in Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT) at the University Health Network, and teaches and conducts research in Acceptance and Commitment Therapy (ACT).



He has been involved in community-based research projects related to HIV, mental health stigma, immigrant and refugee mental health, and parents of children with Autism Spectrum Disorder. He is psychiatric consultant to the Hong Fook Mental Health Association and is involved in various mental health promotion and education projects as well as cultural competence training in the community. He offers consultations at Mon Sheong Scarborough Long-Term Care Centre. He is the President of the Society of the Study of Psychiatry and Culture and the Chair of the Transcultural Section of the Canadian Psychiatric Association. He is the past Chair and current Historian of the Federation of Chinese American and Chinese Canadian Medical Societies. He is the past Chair of the Ontario Chapter of the Association of Contextual Behavioral Science (ACBS) and was a member of the Diversity Committee of ACBS. He is a Fellow of the American Psychiatric Association, the Canadian Psychiatric Association, and the Association of Contextual Behavioral Science. Other recognitions include the 2015 Social Responsibility Award from the University of Toronto Faculty of Medicine, the 2016 American Psychiatric Association Foundation Award for Advancing Minority Health, the 2017 College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario Council Award, the 2018 Psychotherapy Award for Academic Excellence from the University of Toronto Department of Psychiatry, and the Canada 150 Medal.

Petty Officer First Class Charles Bressette enrolled with the Royal Canadian Navy on 28 Feb 2003 in Toronto, Ontario after graduating from the high school. As an Ordinary Seaman he was posted to St. Jean-sur-Richelieu, Quebec on the 10 week Basic Military Qualification course.

Stephen graduated in Photography and Digital Image at Humber College in Toronto, and has been working in the field of photography, television, movies and multimedia productions for more than 20 years. He had produced thousands of individual interview series, and had visited more than 300 cities, over 50 countries to film productions.

Starting from 2009, Stephen was invited by various Media Production Companies in China as their overseas producer and collaborated in a documentary production which focuses on the overseas Chinese community. Right now, 66 episodes have been produced, and 55 of them had been broadcasted in multiple mainstream China media stations such as China Central Television, Discovery Journey Channel, Phoenix Television and Tencent Video.

Stephen also has a big heart for the people who are in need. Not only he hosted two successful photography exhibitions for World Vision Canada, but he also coordinated and organized two charity running events called “World Vision Canada Global 6K” and marathon events. He was the top fundraiser in 2017, and his name is listed as a “Legacy” fundraiser at the Headquarter of World Vision Canada. Recognizing his effort in Humanitarian work, Stephen received the “World Vision Canada Diversity in Philanthropy Award” at the 16th Outstanding Asian-Canadian Community Awards Ceremony in 2019.

With his extensive photography journeys in numerous countries all over the world, Stephen was chosen by the Government of Canada to present his photography exhibition at the City Hall in Vaughan, Canada, as part of the 150th Anniversary of Canada's celebration event.
